The aim of this policy is to encourage a smoke free environment within AUSC club rooms, facilities, and playing grounds.

1 Background

In line with the University of Adelaide's, and AU Sport's non-smoking policy, smoking is strictly prohibited in all buildings and parts of buildings (including toilets), as well as those facilities managed by AUSC (boats and club house).

2 Revision

This policy is to be maintained and reviewed by the AUSC Committee.

3 Application

This policy applies to all members who participate in AUSC activities.

4 General recommendations

The following requirements are applied to all sporting and social events:

- No smoking shall occur at or near sporting events. This practice shall apply to coaches, players, trainers, officials and volunteers.
- Social events shall be smoke-free, with smoking permitted at designated outdoor smoking areas.
- Coaches, officials, trainers, volunteers and players will refrain from smoking and remain smoke-free while they are involved in an official capacity, both on and off the field.
- Visiting teams and spectators should be advised via verbal communication and signage that the fields are smoke free environments.
 - Club members are advised that they can politely ask visitors to comply with this Policy however they should not get in an altercation if the smoker does not agree.
 - If it becomes an issue, the University of Adelaide Security should be called to deal with the situation.

5 Penalties

Those that do not comply with these rules and conditions may be subject to their membership being terminated from AUSC, and ban for a period of twelve (12) months.
